On foot: The practice is located on the first floor of a red sandstone tenement building, on one corner of Partick Cross above the Three Judges Pub. Access by tenement staircase only.

Underground: Kelvin Hall stop is just 75 metres away.

Rail: We are only 10 minutes' walk, east of Partick Station
